Harford County Public Schools is offering a tuition program of music lessons to all interested **instrumental music students who will enter grades 5 through 9 in September, 2009**. Summer music study provides strong opportunities for maintenance of playing skills, for remedial instruction as necessary, for further reading and playing skills, and for small ensemble performance experiences.

Please note a change: This year the Summer Music Program will be held for five consecutive days, Monday, July 13 through Friday, July 17 from 9:00 am to 12:00 noon for a total of 15 hours of lessons. Edgewood High School is the location for all lessons - brass, woodwind, percussion, and strings. Students will be grouped according to age and experience. Classes will be offered assuming adequate enrollment. As in the past, parents must provide transportation for their children.

Please send the completed registration form and check to your child's instrumental music teacher **by Wednesday, June 10**.
